Grading Policy, Methods of Assessment

Elements of final grade:

Classroom work

Lectures: (oral answers in class: monologue / dialogical statements, reading, control of grammatical skills, translation skills)

Seminars: Doing homework and independent work, presentations.

Active participation in lectures and seminars are compulsory. The grade for active and informed participation includes discussion (quality and qantity), attitude and attendence (you are not allowed to miss any seminar classes over the semester). Module test evaluation over the course material. comprises 40% of the total mark.

Written assignments is on a five-tiered scale (1–5) and comprises 10% of the total mark.

The course will be completed with an oral exam. The exam comprises 50% of the final grade Grading scale: 0-59 fail, 60-74 pass, 75-89 good, 90-100 excellent
